



SCHEDULE OF FEES FUTURE FARMS

(All prices are subject to GST)



Horses in Full Training: Includes agistment, feeding, training, rugging etc
\$48.40- per day (\$338.80- per week) (short term training fee – horses under 60 days)
\$36.30- per day (\$254.10- per week) (long term training fee – 60 days or longer)

Mobile Training fee: \$66- per horse plus travel (when available)

Horses on Agistment: Includes agistment, feeding, rugging, use of facilities

Stabled horses – hard feeds plus hay

\$30.25 per day (\$211.75 per week) (short term agistment – horses under 60 days)

\$24.20- per day (\$169.40- per week) (long term agistment – 60 days or longer)

Shelter with individual yard – hard feeds plus hay

\$28- per day (\$196- per week) (short term agistment)

\$22- per day (154- per week) (long term agistment)

Paddock Horses – individual paddock – hard feeds plus hay

\$24.20- per day (\$169.40- per week) Short term agistment – horses under 60 days)

\$18.15 per day (\$127.05- per week) long term agistment – 60 days of longer)

Group paddock horses – Hard feed and hay

\$16.50 per day (\$115.50 per week) short term agistment – under 60 days

\$13.20- per day (\$92.40- per week) long term agistment – over 60 days

Mares with foals – add 30% on top of agistment rate

\$250- foaling down charge per mare/foal (if problem foaling/reject mares, rates on request)

Multiple horse discounts:

2 to 3 horses: 10% off training/agistment bill

4 or over horses: 15% off training/agistment bill

Photography / Video Sessions Costs (washing/clipping/preparation/time/etc)

\$165- per horse

Transportation Fees:

Each show on request – starting from \$110- for up to the first 100km, then charged at \$0.50 cents per kilometre. Transport to interstate shows is given at a flat price. If you book your horse to be transported by us for any shows, a quote will be given and accepted by you. If you decide not to take your horse, you will still be invoiced this amount unless the spot is filled with another horse.

Stallions Standing At Stud:

Future Farms can offer the service of standing your Stallion at public or private stud – whatever your requirements may be. Please contact Future Farms directly to discuss your individual needs.

Advertising/Marketing:

Future Farms can organise advertising/marketing of your horses. We regularly are advertising in Magazines, newsletters and on the internet and are happy to discuss your requirements.

Show Entries:

We will assist you in the classes that we recommend for your horse to compete in and what level of show your horse is ready for. Future Farms can enter your horse for you, however will require a signed authority from the owner stating that you authorise Future Farms to enter your horse at any show they see fit.

Show entry/stabling/bedding etc costs are the responsibility of the owner.

Owners will also have a shared charge for overnight shows for a tack/prep box.

Other

- Priority payments must be made prior to shows if you want a particular Future Farms representative/employee to show your horse in its class and as a priority for Champion classes.
- Unless a priority payment has been made, Future Farms will give NO GUARANTEE as to which one of their representatives/employees will show any said horse in any class or championships.
- Invoices are seven day accounts for the month in advance. Accounts are to be paid BY THE DUE DATE or a late fee of \$25- per day is applicable
- Veterinarian fees/farrier costs etc are the responsibility of the owner (*Indicative current prices: Farrier: All round \$99-, trim \$44-, front shoes trim backs \$66-, worming- \$10 1/2 tube / \$20- full tube*)
- Horses are recommended to be insured prior to coming to the property
- All horses, owners, owners guests and equipment/belongings etc are on the premises of Future Farms Training and Breeding Facility at their own risk
- A 10% commission on horses in training, or 20% commission on non training horses is payable to Future Farms on any horses sold through the farm acting as an agent
